TIPS Save Lives!

- Over 5.7 million U.S. teens are estimated to be involved in bullying as a bully, victim or both.
- More than 80% of school-age children surveyed have both engaged in and fallen victim to bullying.
- 80% of bullying is witnessed; but only 10% of witnesses report incidents.
- In 2/3 of school shootings (for which the shooter was still alive to report), the attackers had previously been bullied.
- At least one other person had some type of knowledge of the attacker's plan in 81% of school shooting incidents.
- Suicide is the 3rd leading cause of death among those 15 to 25.
- An estimated 500,000 teenagers try to kill themselves every year, and about 5,000 succeed.
